Who We Are

UCM is an interdenominational emergency assistance ministry founded in 1989 by leaders of the local church community. Our services are made possible by the combined support of area churches, grants, businesses, schools, civic groups & individuals.

What We Do

UCM provides basic needs services to residents of Pickens County (with the exception of Clemson & Central) and northern Anderson County (Powdersville) in times of crisis or unforeseen circumstances.

Emergency Assistance

(food, utilities, clothing & rent)

Clients may come once a month to receive food assistance.

UCM may not be able to pay an entire bill, so financial assistance may be given as a conditional commitment and/or we may refer clients to other agencies to better meet their needs. Typically, financial assistance may be considered every 6 months.

Required Documents

To receive food assistance, a SC driver's license or picture ID is required. If address is not current/accurate, valid proof of residency in our service area is required.

To receive financial assistance, the following items are needed each visit:

- Valid SC driver's license or picture ID
- Social Security cards for each household member
- Proof of total household income for the last 4 weeks (We may not be able to assist without proof of income due to unsustainability.)
- Proof of need (past due or eviction notice for rent assistance or current bill for utility assistance)
- Further proof of need may be required such as receipts, bank statements, etc.
