Most roles require a weekly commitment on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 8:45-noon to help us serve our clients consistently and efficiently.

Volunteer Opportunities:

- **Greeters** – Welcome clients, sign them in for food assistance, and ensure those requesting financial assistance have the required documents. Must have a friendly personality.
- **Receptionists** – Answer and return phone calls, make copies of client documents, and assist the staff receptionist in keeping the financial assistance process running smoothly.
- **Interviewers** – Meet with clients to gather household and financial details, verify their needs, advocate for them with staff, and connect them to other resources. Must be compassionate and patient.
- **Link2Feed Workers** – Use a laptop to enter client information for food assistance. This role requires attention to detail and basic computer skills.
- **Pantry Workers** – Prepare and load food orders for clients and track incoming donations.
- **Stockers** – Sort, stock, and shelve food donations, typically on Tuesdays or Thursdays.
- **Truck Unloaders** – Help unload a USDA food truck every other Tuesday between 9-10 AM. This role requires heavy lifting.
